

## **HOW IT WORKS:**

## POEM REQUIREMENTS:

Poems will be judged by grade level, original content, style, vocabulary, and creative expression.

Participants may submit up to 3 original poems that are no longer than 30 lines each. Submitted poems will not be returned. They must be printed neatly or typed (it must be legible to qualify).

## SUBMITTING YOUR POEM(S):

Submit your poems in person using the Entry Form (see below) by attaching the completed form to your poems. **Any poems submitted in person without this form will not be entered into the contest.**
